Subject: FOIA Request on AGIA Open Season and SB 305 Veto

Dear Governor Parnell:

Pursuant to the Alaska Public Records Act, AS 40.25.120, I write to request access to and a copy of all documents submitted to TransCanada (the "licensee" under the Alaska Gasline Inducement Act, AS 43.90.010 et seq.), or your administration, by all bidders in the open season held by the licensee on August 1, 2010. I also request access to and a copy of all documents currently in possession of the licensee or the executive branch that address your veto of Senate Bill 305.

As you are well aware the state is spending up to \$500 million in its attempt to get North Slope leaseholders to commit gas into a pipeline into Canada, and the Alaska people have a right to know on August 1st if the open season was a success or failure. All conditions attached to any nomination of gas must be made public as well and are to be considered part of this FOIA request.

The public also has a right to know the circumstances leading up to your veto of Senate Bill 305 on April 29, 2010 including whether you or members of your administration had received input on that decision from TransCanada or any North Slope producer. Your veto of Senate Bill 305 offered upwards of \$20 billion of Alaskans future dollars to North Slope producers to encourage them to nominate gas into your proposed gasline into Canada. Alaska's future revenues, in an amount on par with Alaska's Permanent Fund, should not be used to subsidize the collapsed Canadian gas market.

Please treat this as a continuing request for all documents received or generated through August 1, 2010. This request includes paper documents such as correspondence or requests for information and electronic documents such as emails and faxes. Additionally, please notify me as to the estimated cost of complying with this request before incurring expenses for which I will be charged.

For electronic documents such as copies of emails, I prefer that you send these electronically. You can simply forward to me any emails that fall under the request's parameters. You can use my email address info@billwalkerforgovernor.com for this purpose.

I look forward to your response within ten (10) days. Please advise if you intend to comply with the portion of this FOIA request regarding the open season bids and conditions on August 1, 2010.

If you chose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. Also, please provide all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material.
